- Track learner progress and report to the Program Director
- Record hours worked monthly and report them to Program Director
- Ensure set up of your program, as well as clean up when you are done.

- Reliable access to a vehicle.
- Ability to design lesson plans and teach basic technology as well as Microsoft Office, Excel, Google and if possible, QuickBooks.
